

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBDIVISION
3(E) OF 125B.11 OF SECTION 125B.11
CHAPTER 125B OF THE ROCHESTER CODE
OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO ALCOHOL
LICENSES

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCHESTER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Subdivision 3(E) of Section 125B.11 of Chapter 125B of the Rochester Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

- E. in the case of an establishment which is not open for business at the time of the approval of the license by the council, the establishment shall open for business within 45 90 days of the opening date specified in the license application. One 90 day extension of this deadline may be granted by the City Clerk, if requested in writing with the initial 90 days. The City Clerk shall grant an extension only if progress towards opening of an establishment has been demonstrated. If the establishment does not open within the prescribed time and ~~the council does not extend the time,~~ including a City Clerk granted extension if applicable, the approval previously granted shall be deemed rescinded and re- application shall be required.

Section 2. This Ordinance is effective as of the date of its publication.
