



Sanitary Sewer Repair - Rochester City Lines (J4407)

Construction is anticipated to occur in fall 2019.

Deficient sanitary sewer pipe and manholes will be replaced to prevent a break or blockage of the sanitary sewer system.

Project Benefits

The existing sanitary sewer pipe in this area has numerous deficiencies that can lead to blockages in the sewer lines and prevent regular maintenance. Some manholes in the area are settling due to soil conditions and could lead to a sewer main break. The deficient sewer and manholes will be replaced as part of this project.
