

2019 Public Works Construction Project Summary



Multi-Use Path along Highway 14 from Marion Road/15th Avenue SE to East Circle Drive and along College Drive SE from Highway 14 to 8½ Street SE (J4670)

Constructed is expected to start in the spring of 2019 and be completed in summer 2019.

The project consists of the construction of an 8 to 10-foot wide separate multi-use path. One short segment of the path will consist of pedestrian walkways and shared-lanes for bicycles and automobiles.

Project Benefits

The proposed project will enhance connections between destinations in southeast Rochester including Eastwood Plaza, Rochester Community and Technical College (RCTC) and the surrounding neighborhoods. The proposed path will connect three existing multi-use paths, further connecting users to destinations in the area and beyond.

Construction Impacts

Impacts to vehicle traffic:

- Minor impacts are likely to include closing shoulders and boulevard areas on the north side of Highway 14.
- Major travel impacts will occur to the project area between 17th Avenue SE and 21st Avenue SE. Traffic in that segment shall be closed to through traffic, with access only to the abutting property owners.

Impacts to pedestrians:

- The existing sidewalks will be closed during the project. Pedestrians should follow the detour signs.

Project Cost and Funding

The project costs of \$1,200,000 are being funded by Federal Enhancement Funds, Municipal State Aid and tax levy.
