

Rehabilitation of 48th Street NW (J4691)

Construction will resume in spring 2019 and be completed in June 2019

A sidewalk will be constructed along 48 Street NW from 31 Avenue NW to the Highway 52 Frontage Road.

Project Benefits

48th Street NW was formerly a rural section road with no curb and gutter. In 2018 the rehabilitation of this roadway began with the construction of underground storm sewer. The remaining phase of the project involves the construction of a sidewalk along the roadway.

Construction Impacts

Impacts to vehicle traffic:

- Traffic will be intermittently reduced to one lane. Access to area businesses will be maintained.

Impacts to Rochester Public Transit:

- RPT buses might experience slight delays during the intermittent reductions of travel lanes. Bus stops within the project area will be relocated to outside the work zone. Visit www.rptride.com for further details on transit impacts.

Project Cost and Funding

The project costs of \$225,574 and is being funded by special assessments to abutting property owners and Municipal State Aid Funds.
