

West Circle Drive and 26th Street NW Traffic Signal (J6059)

This project will begin in April 2019 and is expected to be completed by the end of June 2019.

The installation of a traffic signal at West Circle Drive and 26th Street NW will accommodate safe travel through the intersection.

Project Benefits

This traffic signal was recommended as part of the 2010 Traffic Impact Study to accommodate traffic generated by the Northwest Commercial Center development. A development agreement was executed in 2011 stating that a traffic signal would be installed at the developer's expense once traffic signal warrants were met. An analysis by City staff in 2016 determined that warrants had been met.

Construction Impacts

Impacts to vehicle traffic:

- Traffic on West Circle Drive will be merged into one lane in each direction. Signs will be posted to reduce the speed of traffic through this work zone.

Impacts to pedestrians:

- Pedestrians will be detoured at times to allow for the construction of the new curb ramps and pedestrian push buttons.

Impacts to Rochester Public Transit (RPT):

- No detours will be required for RPT routes that travel through this work zone. Delays might occur depending on traffic levels.

Project Cost and Funding

A construction contract was awarded for \$464,377. This project is being funded by private developer contributions.
