

15th Avenue NW Bridge Replacement (J7916)

The project is anticipated to start in June 2019 and be completed by the end of August 2019.

The project involves the replacement of an existing 47 year old bridge.

Project Benefits

The current bridge consists of two elliptical culverts that were constructed in 1972 and has been determined to be severely deteriorated beyond the capacity to safely carry legal loads. This bridge was posted to allow lesser vehicle loads in 2016.

The bridge will be replaced with a single 10x4 concrete box culvert. Once the project is complete, the load-posting signs will be removed and allow for heavier vehicles to once again use the bridge.

Public Works was notified in November 2018 that this project was awarded \$220,000 in State Bridge funds.

Construction Impacts

Impacts to vehicle traffic:

- 15th Avenue NW will be closed to through traffic. Traffic will need to detour using local streets.

Impacts to pedestrians and cyclists:

- The sidewalks along each side of the bridge will be closed at different times. Pedestrians and cyclists will be detoured around the project.

Project Cost and Funding

The construction cost is estimated at \$320,000 with funding coming from State Bridge Funds and Municipal State Aid Funds.
