

1st Street NW Sanitary Sewer Diversion to Broadway (J7830)

Construction will begin in the spring of 2020 and is expected to be completed in fall 2020.

Additional sanitary sewer capacity in downtown will be created by installing a diversion pipe that will bring the sanitary flow from 1st Avenue NW and 3rd Street NW to the existing trunk sewer located at Broadway Avenue North and 1st Street NW.

Project Benefits

This project will provide additional sanitary sewer capacity for growth within the Downtown Destination Medical Center (DMC) area. Additionally, the project will allow for more cost-effective sanitary sewer replacements to be completed with the improvements to North Broadway.

Construction Impacts

Impacts to vehicles:

- 3rd Street NW will be closed from 1st Avenue NW to Broadway Avenue North
- Broadway Avenue North will be reduced to two lanes during construction.
- Access to businesses on Broadway Avenue North will be impacted.

Impacts to pedestrians:

- Sidewalks along 3rd Street NW will be closed during construction.

Impacts to Rochester Public Transit (RPT) users:

- Buses traveling along Broadway and have stops in this corridor may be impacted during construction.
