AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION b OF SECTION 4-7-15 AND SUBSECTION b(2) OF SECTION 4-7-16 OF CHAPTER 4-7 OF THE ROCHESTER CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO HERITAGE PRESERVATION

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCHESTER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Subsection b of Section 4-7-15 of Chapter 4-7 of the Rochester Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

(b) To be eligible for designation on the inventory as a potential landmark property, the individual building, site, structure or object, or a collection thereof, must have a demonstrated quality of significance as determined by the criteria provided in section ~~4-7-8 19B.08, subd. 2~~. The commission shall determine if the property should be designated as a potential landmark property based on the designation criteria.

Section 2. Subsection b(2) of Section 4-7-16 of Chapter 4-7 of the Rochester Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

(2) The commission shall meet and make a recommendation pursuant to section 4-7-8 ~~19B.08~~ of this chapter to council to proceed with designating the property as a landmark property or as part of a landmark district or to allow the land use application or demolition application to continue.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective from the date of publication.
