

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 11-6-49 OF CHAPTER 11-6 OF TITLE 11 OF THE ROCHESTER CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO SEASONAL PARKING RESTRICTIONS.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCHESTER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 11-6-49 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 11-6-49. – Seasonal Parking Restrictions

- (a) No person shall park or leave standing any vehicle on any street in the city on any day between the hours of 2:00 am and 3:00 pm beginning October 1 and ending May 1, except as hereinafter provided:
1. On even-numbered calendar dates, vehicles may be parked on the near side of the street adjacent to properties which have been assigned even numbers; and
 2. On odd-numbered calendar dates, vehicles may be parked on the near side of the street adjacent to properties which have been assigned odd numbers.
 - ~~3. Parking is prohibited within the bulb of any cul-de-sac.~~
- (b) This division does not apply to any street where parking is limited to one side, any street which has more restrictive parking requirements, nor to any metered parking spaces.
- (c) Signs announcing the existence of the seasonal parking restrictions ordinance shall be placed at all major roadway entrances to the city.
- (d) In the event a snow emergency is declared per section 11-8-3, then these seasonal parking restrictions remain in effect for the duration of the snow emergency. Vehicles in violation of the seasonal parking restrictions during a snow emergency may be removed and towed without regard to the waiting period, pursuant to section 11-8-5 and to the extent allowed by state law.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective as of the date of its publication.
