

DISPOSAL OF TREES AND BRUSH

In November 2004, the City Council adopted an amendment to the Rochester Zoning Ordinance and Land Development Manual. The text of the amendment is as follows:

61.200 SUBDIVISION ACTIVITIES:

The requirements of Sections 61.200 through 61.584 identify approvals that will be required to authorize any subdivision activity which is defined as a subdivision by statute or City ordinance. Any person seeking approval of subdivision activity, development activity or a conditional use permit must indicate whether there will be burning of brush, trees or debris that will be cleared as part of the subdivision activity.

In order to apply this provision, you will need to indicate at the bottom of the page plans for disposal of trees, slash, and brush. Please sign and date the form. You must submit this information to the Planning Department prior to applying for a burning permit from the Fire Department. If plans change prior to obtaining a burning permit, you will need to notify the Planning Department.

Within this development as proposed through the development application, trees, slash, and brush will be disposed by:

- Burning on site
- Chipping on site
- Salvaging and removing from the property
